Principal's Report

Melissa: Overall, the school year has been difficult because of low enrollment. YCCS and CPS are renegotiating renewal. Criteria has been changed and making it harder for schools to meet cps expectations. Metrics for rating schools are making it difficult. We need to recoup students by Jan. 19th to enroll over 100 students.

Melissa: YCCS has a high percentage of STLS students.

Rebecka: Mental health hospital needed in the community. How do we enroll more students?

Melissa: YCCS has a marketing strategy to geo-tag based on areas to send out to people. YCCS is hiring a full-time bi-lingual recruiter.

Rebecka: Student-to-student referral is best.

Melissa: contact counselors and social workers in the school to recruit students.

Marvin: All schools want to hang on to students. Keeping school open is one important thing. Lizzette is working on accreditation with youth build. 4 positions paid by grant for salary, Sustainable community of schools grant 400,000. This will benefit the school, but enrollment is a big important part of it.

Lizzette: We have half a million dollars from youth build since we started. A lot of resources behind this program but they need strong marketing.

Milagros: What is the process for referring students?

Melissa: Send the parent directly to Melissa, and she will take care of it and have someone register the

Marvin: He went to see Milagros; She is going through chemo and holistic healing.

Fiscal Report: Michael reviewed spreadsheet displays expenses on track. Cash flow is good. The big problem is the enrollment gap and the revenue that comes in to compensate. Surplus to transform Haddon building. How to adjust to this situation. The project to work on over the next 6 months is enrollment. No immediate crisis but we need to be careful moving forward.

Melissa: We need to have 130 students returning in June.

Melissa: become accredited by ISB instead of CPS. 14,000 per student if directly coming from ISB.

Marvin: \$240,000 in the account. ASM owes over 200,000.

Lizzette: 12 potential students for dual enrollment.

Evelyn: Create a list of information with the pros of coming here. Smaller classes get more personal

attention.
